 1. Information and suggestions from the classroom teacher on a regular basis
 2. Mid-quarter reports from the school.
 3. Quarterly grade cards/reports sent home.

- Be accessible to parents through -
 1. Phone calls or person-to-person meetings.
 2. Scheduled consultation before, during, or after school.
 3. Scheduled school or home visits, as needed.


Family Responsibilities I, as a parent, will support my child's learning in the following ways:
